This agreement is an informative tool for you to assess the time and financial commitment that is involved with being a member of the Bentonville Pride Marching Band.

Obligation and Commitment

The performance and rehearsal schedule for the Bentonville Pride requires a <u>strong commitment</u> from each student as well as a commitment from family and other support units. We will compete with the best band programs in the nation with a **state-of-the-art** marching show created by the best designers in the nation. This endeavor will be worthwhile and a **once-in-a-lifetime** opportunity that will build your students' confidence, perseverance, problem-solving skills, and teamwork. There is a financial obligation for transportation, lodging, meals, contest preparation, and fees. The Bentonville Band Boosters offers 100% fundraising opportunities to help offset the "fare share" fee as well as scholarships for students on a free and reduced lunch program.

This season the Pride will be traveling to Tulsa, OK for the Renegade Review. St. Louis, MO. for the Bands of America Super Regional, Rogers, AR for Regional Marching Assessment, Little Rock, AR for the State Marching Contest and Indianapolis IN for Grand Nationals. The *All-Inclusive* payment is \$1500 for Winds, Percussion and Color Guard.. Any changes will come off the LAST payment. No additional fees will be required for travel.

Instrument Rental

All members are not allowed to miss rehearsals except in the case of injury that prevents them from attending, documented illness, or immediate death in the family. Please schedule necessary appointments around the rehearsal schedule.

Attendance Policy

Members of the Bentonville Pride are only allowed 3 absences from rehearsals before they lose their Full Cast Status. Students are responsible to check in with their section leaders for each rehearsal for accurate attendance.

Contractual Agreement

We as a family understand the contractual agreements of the Bentonville Pride. We understand the rehearsal schedule and attendance policy. We take full responsibility for the financial costs of the program and understand that any unpaid fees may withhold the release of student records such as diploma/transcripts.
