



Parents and Students – It's that time again ... time to sell chocolate

Each chocolate box has 60 candy bars in a variety of flavors: milk chocolate, dark chocolate, and more. Bars sell for \$1.00 each; the box contains an envelope for collecting money.

- There must be a SIGNED permission slip on file BEFORE your student can check out a box of chocolate.
- Your band or guard student's CHARMS account will be charged \$30.00 when the candy is checked out.
- Money MUST be turned in before another box of chocolate can be checked out.
- Once checked out, boxes of chocolate, even unopened, may not be returned.
- Please no door-to-door selling – your student's safety is important.
- SELLING OF CHOCOLATE BARS **CANNOT** occur during school hours or in the school building. You may sell candy bars outside of the school building beginning at 2:30PM.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE COULD RESULT IN YOU NOT BEING ABLE TO PARTICIPATE ANY FURTHER IN THIS FUNDRAISER AND YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY FOR THE BOX IN FULL.

When the envelope is counted, the amount collected will be recorded in your student's CHARMS account. Selling a full box of chocolate will result in a profit of \$30.00, which applies toward any amount owed for band travel costs. Any shortage or overage will be reflected in the amount of profit.

**To ensure prompt posting of your child's money, submit the \$60.00 in check, money order or in bills.
Receipt of coins will delay posting due to the counting time involved.**
